HOW TO APPLY ONLINE

To start your submission, you will create an account on our **symposium site:** https://pednig.fsel.ca/ (Note this is different than the main PedNIG website). When you have your account, the site will prompt you to sign in to begin your submission. To start a submission, click "edit profile here" under the log in on the right-hand side. You are able complete the submission over multiple sessions, but all information must be provided before **April 1, 2020**. Be sure to provide all requested information.

To submit your completed application, please visit the abstract page of our website and click the "save/submit" button at the bottom of the page.

OTHER INFORMATION

All presenters are responsible for all expenses incurred and must register for the conference. Concurrent paper are 30 minutes inclusive of a 10 minute question period. Posters will be set up in a common area for viewing through-out the day.

CONTENT

Your abstract should be informative stating the problem, issue or project in the first paragraph. Briefly describe the manner in which the study, issue or project was addressed and describe the findings, conclusions, or solutions. Evaluate the relevance of this study, innovation or strategy to other pediatric settings. Authors are expected to clearly outline key learning objectives for their presentation.

SELECTION PROCESS

All abstracts received by the deadline date will be subjected to a "blind" peer review. Selection criteria include relevance to the conference theme, scholarship, creativity and application to pediatric nursing.

A greater emphasis is being placed on completed work, lessons to be learned, and innovative contribution to the pediatric health care system. Selection will be completed and acknowledged by email by **May 1, 2020.**
