## Caring for the Entire Unit: Environments that Promote Recovery in Acute Care Mental Health Settings

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Psychiatric and mental health nurses have a level of responsibility for every person residing on an acute care mental health unit, which contributes to the need to nurse the population on the unit as a whole. Mental health service provision has embraced the concept of recovery-oriented care. However, acute care mental health settings continue to follow the medical model. A recovery-oriented milieu is fostered through healthy relationships among team members, clients, family members, and formal supports. Awareness of the client, self, and environment are used to assess the state of the unit milieu and care for the entire unit.

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
