It was wonderful to participate in RNAO's 22nd annual Queens Park Day (QPD) on February 24th, 2022. QPD has always been my favourite RNAO activity, where I feel the most connection to what we are there to accomplish. The virtual format did decrease the feelings of camaraderie but the RNAO team did their best to engage the almost 100 members present this year. The event featured a video presentation of the RNAO's provincial election platform, followed by presentations from all political party leaders and health critics, with an opportunity for those present to engage in Q&A. Later in the day a panel of experts, led by president-elect Claudette Holloway, reviewed the platform and the party responses to it. It was good to hear their expert opinions on how critical it is for nurses today to be politically active and to advocate for our patients, their health, and the health care system.
